

Synopsis

February 2019 was cooler than normal and much wetter than normal across western New Mexico, while the east was slightly warmer than normal and much drier than normal. February was also windy on several days, especially across the plains. Several heavy snowfall events impacted the high terrain of northern and western New Mexico. Chama was basically buried in snow by the middle of the month. An exceptionally rare and dramatic "snowspout" was observed over rural areas of eastern McKinley County on February 17th.






Temperature

Precipitation




The average statewide temperature was 38.0°, which was 0.2° above the long-term normal of 37.8° (1901-2000).

The average statewide precipitation was 0.61", which was 0.03" below the long-term normal of 0.64" (1901-2000).









The average temperature for Albuquerque was 39.9°, which was 1.5° below the normal of 41.4°. The average maximum temperature for the month was 51.5°. This was 1.0° below the normal average maximum temperature of 52.5°. The average minimum temperature for the month was 28.3°. This was 2.0° below the normal average minimum temperature of 30.3°.





The average temperature for Clayton was 35.3°, which was 2.2° below the normal of 37.5°. The average maximum temperature for the month was 51.1°. This was 0.2° below the normal average maximum temperature of 51.3°. The average minimum temperature for the month was 19.4°. This was 4.2° below the normal average minimum temperature of 23.6°. This ranks as the 32nd coolest February on record (1893-2019).






The average temperature for Roswell was 47.9°, which was 2.2° above the normal of 45.7°. The average maximum temperature for the month was 65.2°. This was 4.5° above the average maximum temperature of 60.7°. The average minimum temperature for the month was 30.6°. This was 0.1° below the normal average minimum temperature of 30.7°. This ranks as the 26th warmest February on record (1893-2019).



Precipitation – Climate Sites



There was 0.50" of precipitation measured at the Sunport, compared to the normal of 0.48", or 0.02" above normal. This ranks as the 34th wettest February on record (1893-2019).

There was 0.37" of precipitation measured at Clayton, compared to the normal of 0.34", or 0.03" above normal. This ranks as the 39th wettest February on record (1893-2019).

There was a trace of precipitation measured at Roswell, compared to the normal of 0.42", or 0.42" below normal. This ranks as the 9th driest February on record (1893-2019).
