

Strong Winds and Fire Weather Concerns


Wind Advisory

- → Wind Advisory for South Dakota Counties from late morning through this afternoon
- → Strong winds with gusts of 40 to 55 mph this afternoon across South Dakota

Red Flag Warning

- → Red Flag Warning for south central South Dakota this afternoon
- → Dry conditions with low relative humidity values this afternoon of 10 to 20% over south central South Dakota

Red Flag Warning and Wind Advisories Today






Avoid any burning or outdoor activities that may cause sparks.



Strong Winds Today

- → Wind gusts out of the west peaking 40 to 55 mph, strongest over north central South Dakota
- → Strongest winds late this morning through mid afternoon
- → Strong winds and ongoing dry weather will result in elevated fire weather concerns this afternoon over mainly south central South Dakota

Dry Today - Low Relative Humidity

Elevated Fire Weather Concerns over south central South Dakota this afternoon


→ Lowest Relative Humidity of 10 to 20% over south central South Dakota

→ Strong winds and ongoing dry weather will result in elevated fire weather concerns this afternoon over mainly south central South Dakota

WILDFIRE PREVENTION





Do not use a lawn mower on weeds or dry grass



Properly dispose of cigarettes and matches



Avoid power equipment that creates sparks



Make sure no vehicle parts drag on the ground, including towing chains

CHECK TIRE PRESSURE

DRIVING ON EXPOSED WHEEL RIMS WILL THROW SPARKS



DO NOT THROW CIGARETTES OUT YOUR WINDOW!
BE CAUTIOUS WITH FARM EQUIPMENT
CHECK LOOSE CHAINS ON TRAILERS AND EQUIPMENT
DO NOT BURN WITHOUT CHECKING THE FORECAST
