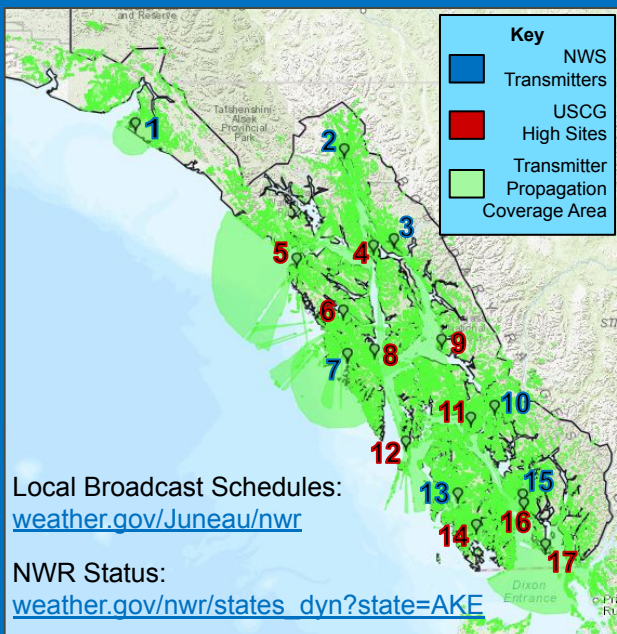

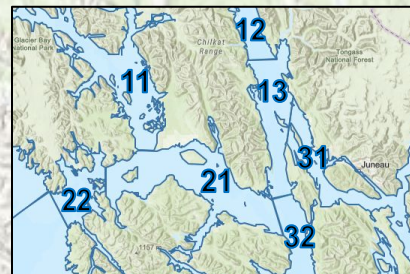

## MARINE ADVISORY & WARNING CRITERIA

*Issued for the next 24hrs*

Small Craft Advisory.....23-33kt  
≥ 8ft seas  
Gale Warning.....34-47kt  
Storm Warning.....48-63kt  
Hurricane Force.....≥ 64kt

### Heavy Freezing Spray Warning:

Issued for imminent or occurring icing  
conditions of >2cm/hr accretion

**Special Marine Warning:** Alert of  
hazardous conditions of short duration  
(≤2hrs) producing marine  
thunderstorm winds ≥34kt, large hail,  
and/or waterspouts.
