

Here is a look at some 4th of July weather statistics for Elizabeth City, NC, with data going back to 1934. While there is some variability in the temperatures on the 4th of July, warm to hot temperatures are the rule. Highs have ranged from the lower 70s to 100 degrees and low temperatures have been as cool as the mid 50s and as warm as the upper 70s. The long term average high is in the upper 80s with an average low in the upper 60s. *About two in three Fourth of Julys will have a high temperature between 83 and 93 F and a low temperature between 63 and 74 F.* While measurable precipitation occurs fairly frequently, it is usually associated with afternoon and evening thunderstorms rather than all day rain. It has never snowed in Elizabeth City on the 4th of July.
