

Here is a look at some 4th of July weather statistics for Salisbury, MD, with data going back to 1906. While there is some variability in the temperatures on the 4th of July, warm to hot temperatures are the rule. Highs have ranged from the upper 60s to 100 degrees and low temperatures have been as cool as the lower 50s and as warm as the upper 70s. The long term average high is in the upper 80s with an average low in the mid 60s. *About two in three Fourth of Julys will have a high temperature between 81 and 92 F and a low temperature between 59 and 71 F.* While measurable precipitation occurs fairly frequently, it is usually associated with afternoon and evening thunderstorms rather than all day rains. It has never snowed in Salisbury on the 4th of July.
