Subject: Discontinuation of river forecast services at 5 streamflow gages supported by the NWS Forecast Office in Albany, NY

Beginning on June 10, 2026, river flood forecasts produced by NWS Albany for 5 USGS stream gages will be discontinued. This change is being made after coordination with local town officials. The following sites are:
