

NOAA Weather Radio WXM-68 Back on the Air

NOAA Weather Radio WXM-68, operating at a frequency of 162.425 MHz has resumed operations. The transmitter, formerly at Ames Hill, Vermont, has moved to Leyden, Massachusetts.

National Weather Service watch, warning and advisory alerts, as well as routine weather information, will be broadcast for the following counties on WXM-68.

In Massachusetts: Berkshire, Franklin and Hampshire Counties.

In New Hampshire: Cheshire County.

In Vermont: Bennington and Windham Counties.
