Cotton fields were open and ready to be harvested...however the cotton was beaten out of the bolls by the small hail. Unopened bolls were bruised from the small hail and will never open. On some of the peanut crops...the peanuts were already partially dug and laying on top of the ground waiting to be thrashed. The small hail caused the peanuts to fall from the vines making them impossible to harvest.

A non-severe thunderstorm producing small dime sized hail over the southeastern Texas panhandle during the afternoon hours caused crop damage in the town of Quail Texas. No injuries were reported.
