April Highlights

- A rather uneventful, slightly cooler than normal pattern persisted during the month of April.
- The dry pattern established this past winter season continued, with all of northern Michigan experiencing near to below normal precipitation.
- Per the usual, some snow was observed during the month, although nearly all locations reported below normal totals.
- Much like the last several years, severe weather season has been slow to arrive, with no reports of severe thunderstorms for the month.
