The aftermath of the hail storm which struck the Bismarck/Mandan area Saturday evening June 9, 2001.

An approaching upper level system provided lift to produce severe thunderstorms over central North Dakota Saturday afternoon and evening. Abundant low level moisture combined with relatively cool air aloft lead to the formation of an incredible amount of hail with many of these storms. The hail caused a tremendous amount of damage to homes and vehicles in the Bismarck and Mandan area's. A estimated damage from the hail in the two cities amounted around \$260 million. The wind speed associated with the storm ranged between 50 to 60 mph.
