An upper level disturbance moved across a shallow boundary of arctic air covering the northern plains and produced a narrow band of heavy snow across southern North Dakota. The heaviest snowfall of 6 to 8 inches fell just north of the North Dakota southern border from Hettinger to Selfridge to Strasburg. A more general snowfall of 2 to 5 inches fell from the South Dakota border, northward to just south of Interstate 94 in southern North Dakota.
