Low pressure over the northern Rockies moved through the Dakotas and brought ample moisture northward ahead of it. Winter storm criteria was met in Divide, Burke, Renville, Williams, and Mountrail counties. Freezing rain fell at the onset, especially in Burke County. Crosby and Bowbells both had 7 inches of snow and wind gusts to 35 mph with reduced visibility in blowing snow. Tioga had 6 inches of snow with gusty wind and blowing snow. In Burke County conditions were described as blizzard like at times. Watches were issued Sunday afternoon November 26. Warnings were issued in the early morning hours of the 27th.
