An Alberta Clipper moving across the region created a tight pressure gradient over western and central North Dakota. This resulted in high winds during the afternoon hours of Monday, January 8th. Mesonet data showed the highest wind gusts in excess of 65 mph across parts of Stark, Morton, and Burleigh counties.
