A line of severe thunderstorms tracked across the region on April 25th. Numerous reports of downed trees and power lines were received. A series of slow moving thunderstorms resulted in excessive rainfall and flash flooding over southern Mobile County. Numerous locations across the area reported rainfall totals in excess of 7 inches, with a few locations west of Tillmans Corner receiving just under 11 inches of rain. The highest rainfall report received was 10.94 inches from a CoCoRAHS observer 4 miles west northwest of Tillmans Corner. Mobile Regional Airport recorded a daily rainfall record of 7.28 inches for April 12th, with the majority of the rainfall occurring during the evening hours.

This copious rainfall in a short duration resulted in flash flooding and the closure of numerous roads. A portion of Halls Mill Rd was covered by nearly 6 feet of water. A person had to be rescued from a vehicle on McDonald Rd near Interstate 10. Another vehicle was submerged on Old Pascagoula Rd near McDonald Rd. A portion of Warren Creek Rd was washed out in Grand Bay. Several other roads across southern Mobile County experienced 2 to 3 feet of water flowing over them during the height of the event.

Widespread inundation persisted across southern Mobile County in the wake of the flash flood event. Numerous roads remained closed through midday, with water receding by early afternoon. By mid to late afternoon, all roads that were not damaged from the flash flood were reopened.

The combination of a stalled frontal boundary along the coast and near record levels of deep layer moisture resulted in several rounds of very heavy rain over southern Mobile County during the evening of April 12th into the early morning hours of April 13th. This heavy rainfall resulted in flash flooding over many locations.
