The combination of an upper level disturbance, weak cold front, and high levels of moisture and instability resulted in the development of a line of thunderstorms that moved northwest to southeast across the area. One of the storms became severe across Mobile County during the afternoon of June 27th.

Severe thunderstorm wind gusts blew down several large trees in Georgiana near Interstate 65.

Numerous thunderstorms developed across inland southwest Alabama and south central Alabama during the late morning and afternoon of June 30. The storms quickly weakened and produced a large outflow boundary that moved south toward coastal Alabama and resulted in numerous sub severe wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph. One severe thunderstorm developed ahead of this outflow and impacted Butler County AL.

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
