Afternoon thunderstorms produced a couple areas of damage on June 6. Most damage involved downed trees and power lines, although a few trees fell on homes. Early the next morning, June 8, a left-moving cell on the backside of a stratiform rain mass briefly intensified and produced quarter-size hail in Fayette County.

Afternoon convection resulted in a few strong to severe storms, with areas of tree damage in Cherokee, Jefferson, Tallapoosa, and Chambers counties. Later that evening, slow-moving thunderstorms dropped a few inches of rain over southern Lamar County, with several roadways being flooded or washed out.

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homes, vehicles, or power lines. More afternoon thunderstorms lingered over the Birmingham metro on June 18, causing minor flooding of several area roadways around downtown Birmingham, Homewood, and Irondale.
