Discontinue Forecast Service For:
South Platte River near Atwood in Logan County in Northeast Colorado
(ATWC2)

The South Platte River gauge at Atwood, CO (ATWC2) has been discontinued by the gauge owner, so forecast services are also being discontinued for this location. The Colorado Department of Natural Resources have established a new gauge 6 miles upstream of the Atwood gauge location, near Merino, CO (MRIC2), where forecast and warning services for this portion of the South Platte River will transition to use gauge data from the Merino, CO (MRIC2) gauge.

Beginning at noon on Wednesday, June 17, 2026, NOAA's National Weather Service (NWS) Office in Denver/Boulder, CO will discontinue River Forecast Services for the South Platte River near Atwood, Colorado.

At noon on June 17th, NWS Denver/Boulder will cease issuing hydrologic products that include specific river forecasts for ATWC2. The hydrologic products are listed in the following table:
