WHEREAS, beyond fatalities, lightning inflicts devastating life-long, severe injuries; and

WHEREAS, residents and visitors to Colorado enjoy a wealth of outdoor recreational activities, which make them more vulnerable to being struck by lightning; and

WHEREAS, Colorado on average since 1980, has documented three fatalities and twelve injuries per year; and

WHEREAS, Colorado is ranked fourth by population in the Nation when it comes to lightning fatalities for years 1959 through 2017; and

WHEREAS, the vast majority of lightning casualties could be prevented if people follow simple lightning safety guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the key to understanding the dangers of lightning is through education and awareness; and

Therefore, I, John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby proclaim, the period between June 25, 2018 and June 29, 2018, as
