NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE BROWNSVILLE TX

...DOLLY CONTINUES TO PRODUCE HEAVY RAINS...

.AT 400 AM PM CDT...THE CENTER OF HURRICANE DOLLY WAS LOCATED NEAR
LATITUDE 26.9 NORTH...LONGITUDE 98.6 WEST OR ABOUT 95 MILES
NORTHWEST OF BROWNSVILLE.

DOLLY IS MOVING TOWARD THE WEST-NORTHWEST NEAR 7 MPH...11 KM/HR. A
CONTINUED MOTION TOWARD THE WEST-NORTHWEST IS EXPECTED DURING THE
NEXT DAY OR SO...WITH A SLIGHT INCREASE IN FORWARD SPEED UNTIL THE
SYSTEM DISSIPATES ON FRIDAY.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 60 MPH...95 KM/HR...WITH HIGHER
GUSTS. DOLLY IS EXPECTED TO WEAKEN AS IT MOVES FARTHER INLAND...AND
IT IS EXPECTED TO BECOME A TROPICAL DEPRESSION BY TONIGHT.

DOLLY IS EXPECTED TO PRODUCE ADDITIONAL RAINFALL AMOUNTS OF 3 TO 6
INCHES WITH ISOLATED HIGHER AMOUNTS TODAY THROUGH TONIGHT. THE
HEAVIEST RAIN WILL BE ACROSS WESTERN AND NORTHERN AREAS OF DEEP
SOUTH TEXAS.

FOR THE EVENT...CURRENT DATA SUGGESTS A TOTAL OF 10 TO 15 INCHES AREA WIDE FROM WEDNESDAY THROUGH LAST NIGHT. WITH LOCALLY HIGHER AMOUNTS RANGING FROM 20 TO 25 INCHES POSSIBLE.
