Subject: Establishment of Minor Flood Stage for the stream  
gage at Middlebury, VT on the Otter Creek (MDBV1)

Effective at 1200 Coordinated Universal Time on 1 July 2019, the National Weather Service will establish a minor flood stage of 6.5 feet above Gage Zero for the stream gage at Middlebury, VT on the Otter Creek. A flood stage for this gage was previously undefined.

The new minor flood stage will be referenced in flood warnings and flood statements. This change is part of a recent evaluation of the floodplain with local town officials. Other flood categories (moderate and major) will remain undefined.
