Subj: Establishment of Minor and Moderate Flood Stages
for the stream gauge on the Little Salmon River
at Bombay, NY (BOMN6).

Effective at 1200 Universal Coordinated Time (UTC) on Tuesday, September 22, 2026, the National Weather Service will establish Minor and Moderate Flood Stages above Gauge Zero for the stream gauge on the Little Salmon River at Bombay, NY (BOMN6). Those are listed below for reference. Flood stages for this gauge were previously undefined.

Minor Flood Stage	12.0 feet
Moderate Flood Stage	14.0 feet

These new flood stages and accompanying impact statements will help enhance local situational awareness during future high-water events. The establishment of these levels are part of a recent evaluation of the floodplain during which high-level GNS survey measurements were taken and discussions with local officials occurred.
