Webinar Event: The Major Storm of December 23rd and 24th.

A "bomb" cyclone produced a wide range of weather hazards over the North Country. Significant impacts to utilities, some river flooding, wintry weather, and regional blizzard conditions over the St. Lawrence Valley made this one of the more impactful events to have occurred in the North Country. The BTV climate site observed its 2nd highest recorded wind gust of 71 mph in this event to put one number to this major event. This webinar will review the meteorology in forecasting and observing this powerful storm.
