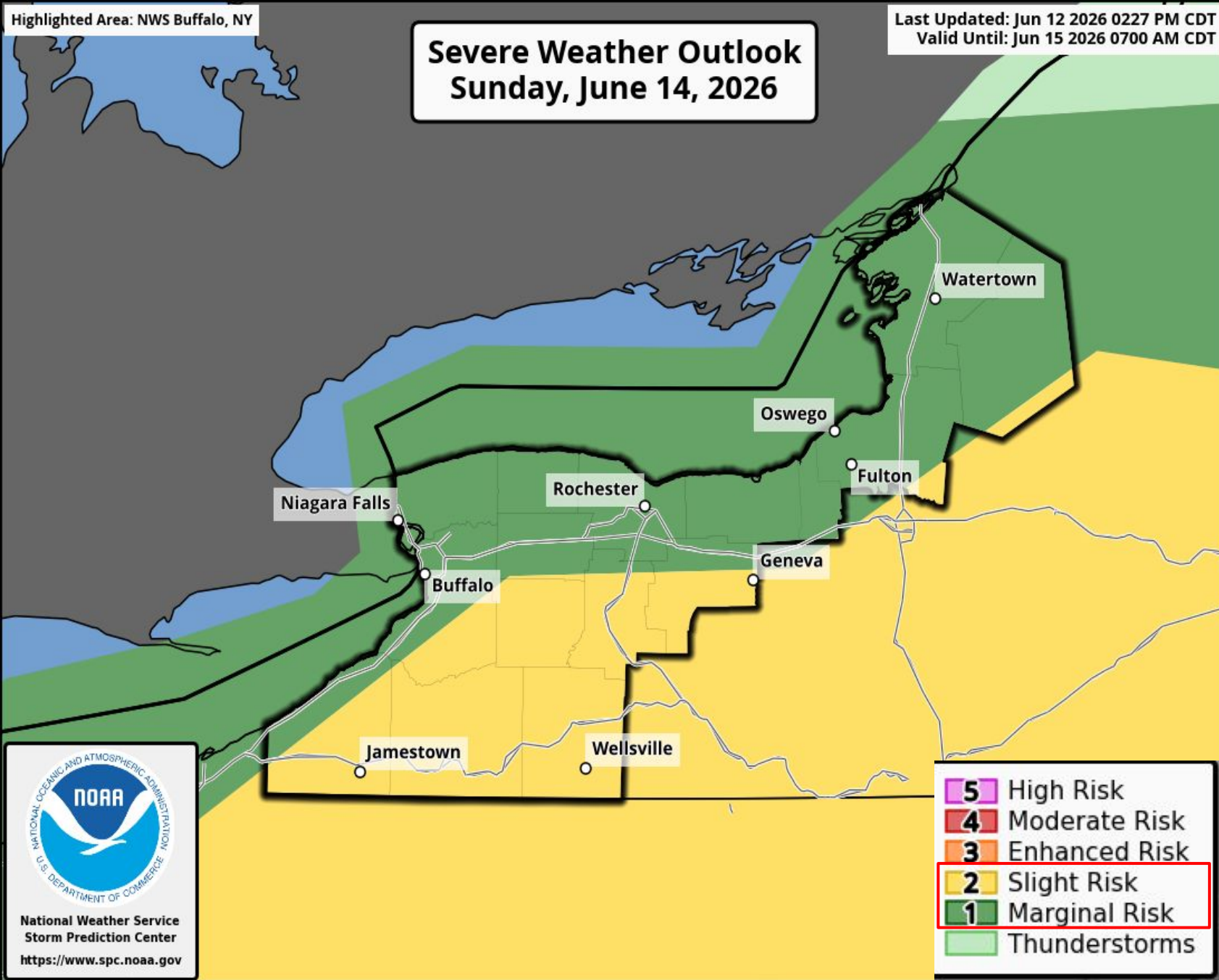


Marginal and Slight Risk of Severe Thunderstorms

Sunday Afternoon and Evening



OVERVIEW & TIMING

- A moist airmass will move into our region Sunday out ahead of an approaching cold front. Strong to severe thunderstorms are possible as the cold front crosses the area
- There is a Marginal to Slight risk of severe storms, with the greatest potential for strong to severe thunderstorms expected across areas inland from Lakes Erie and Ontario
- **Timing:** The main window for for strong to severe storms will be early afternoon into early evening

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Damaging Wind (Primary Threat):** Strong wind gusts may bring down trees and powerlines
- An **isolated tornado** cannot be ruled out

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Uncertainty in the amount of instability that develops during Sunday, which could limit the potential for strong to severe storms

POST EVENT OUTLOOK

- Cooler weather next week
