- More widespread showers and storms Tue and Wed.



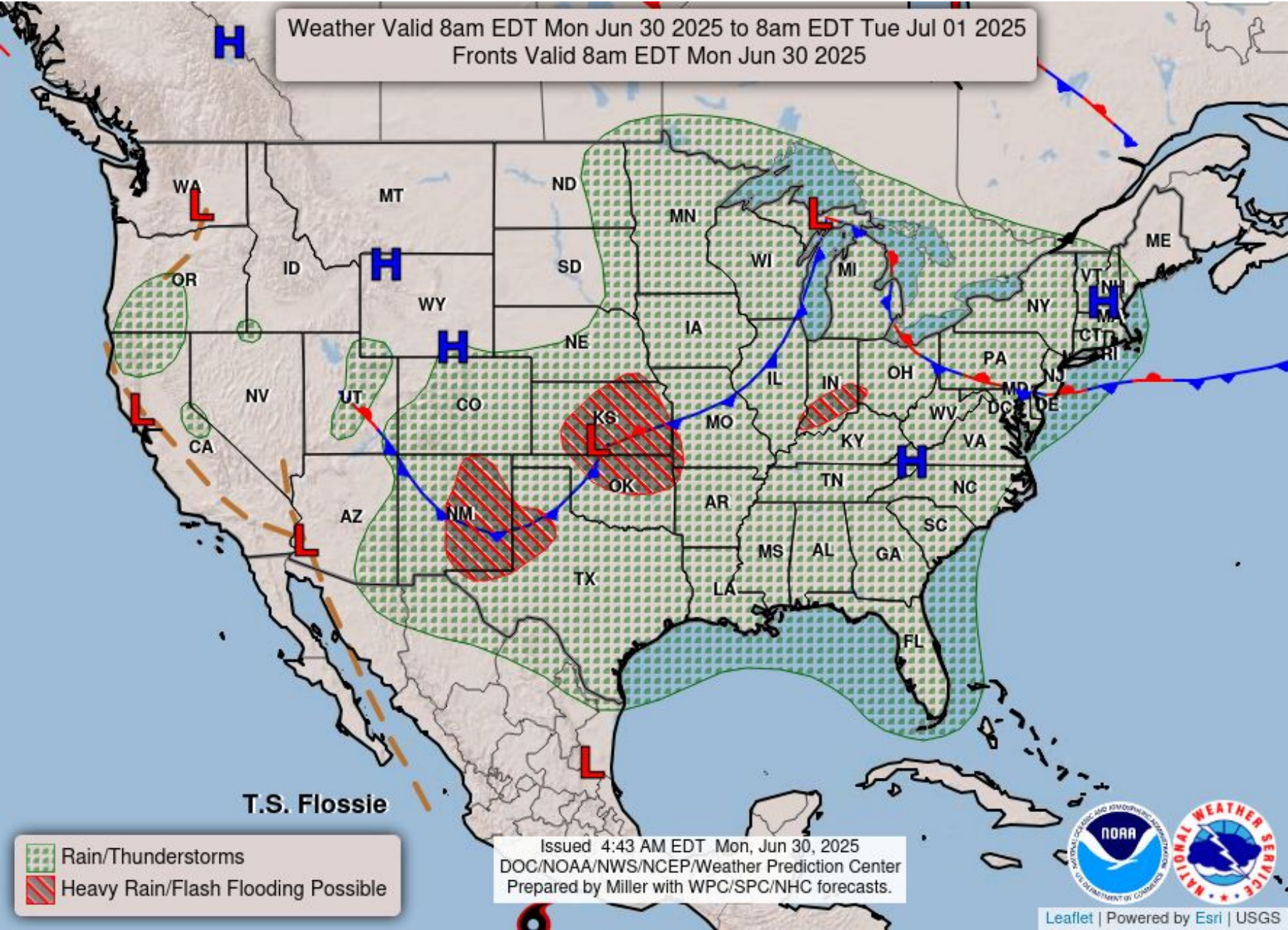

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Scattered afternoon/evening showers and storms. The severe threat remains low but localized flooding is possible given slow storm movement.

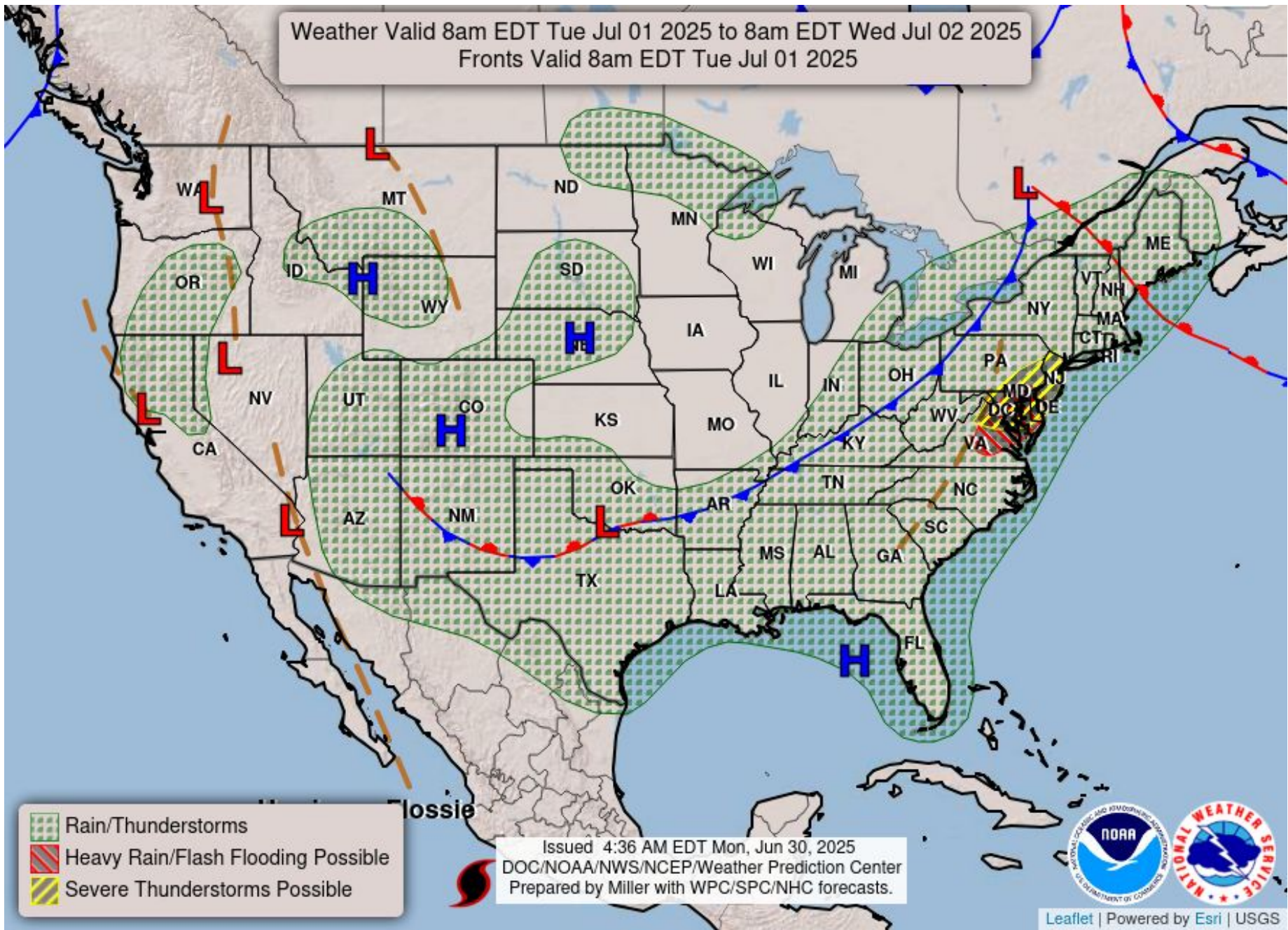
Temperatures will be near normal with highs in the lower 90s.





National Forecast - Tuesday

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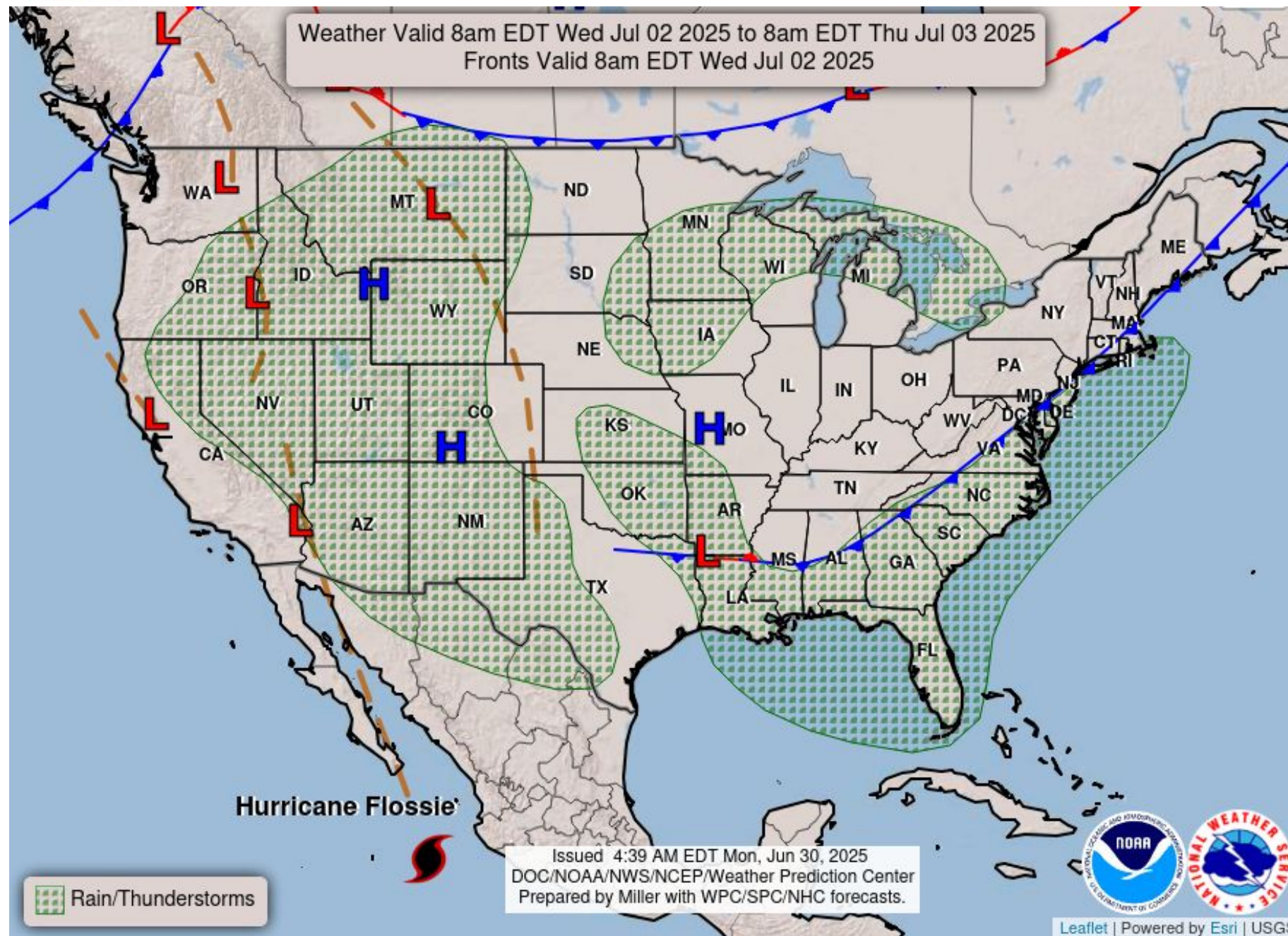
A weak front approaches the Southeast leading to higher thunderstorm chances.





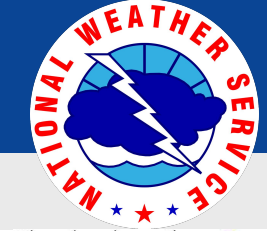
National Forecast - Wednesday

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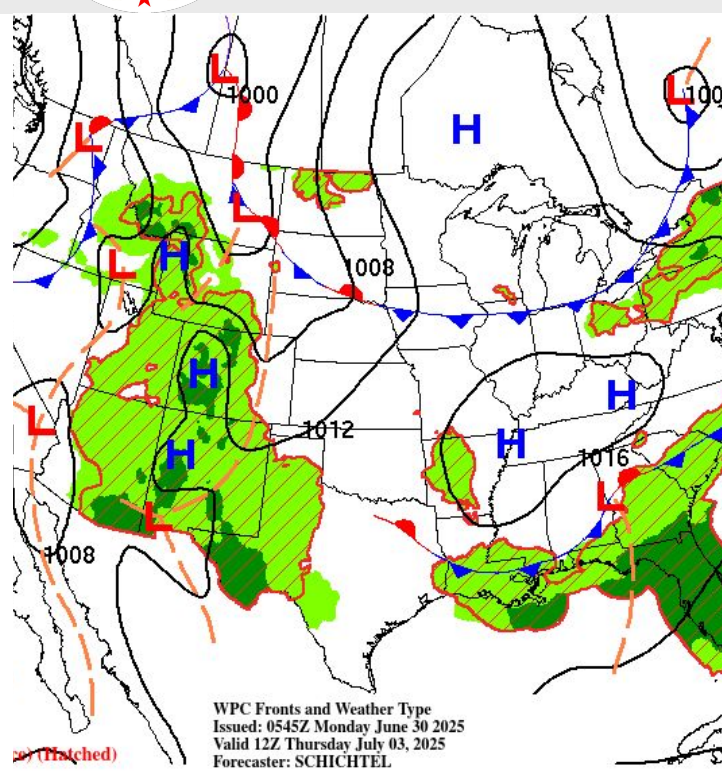
Widespread showers and storms expected as a front sags into the Southeast. Rain may be heavy at times with a marginal risk of flash flooding.



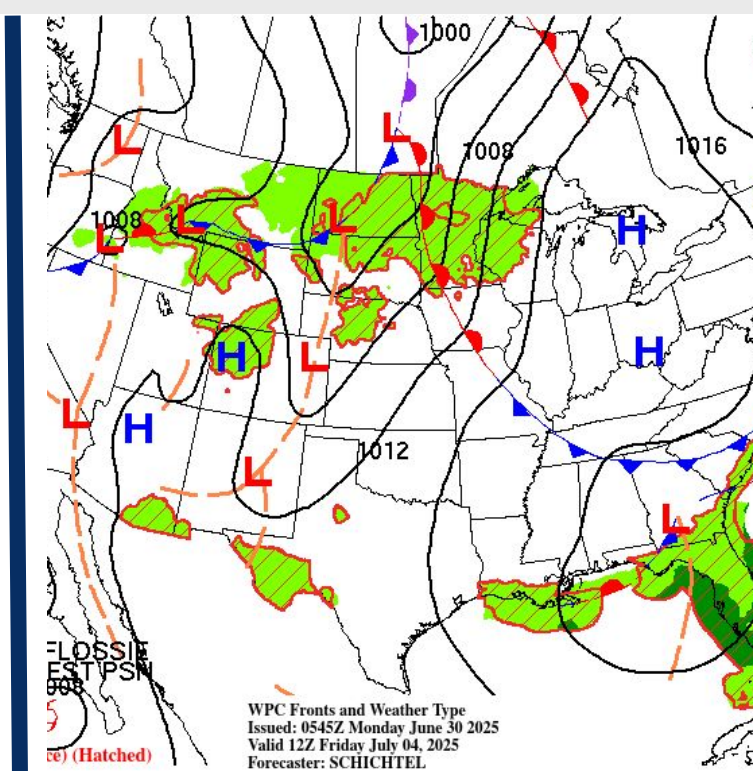

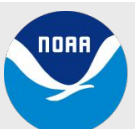

Near normal temperatures with isolated afternoon convection each day.



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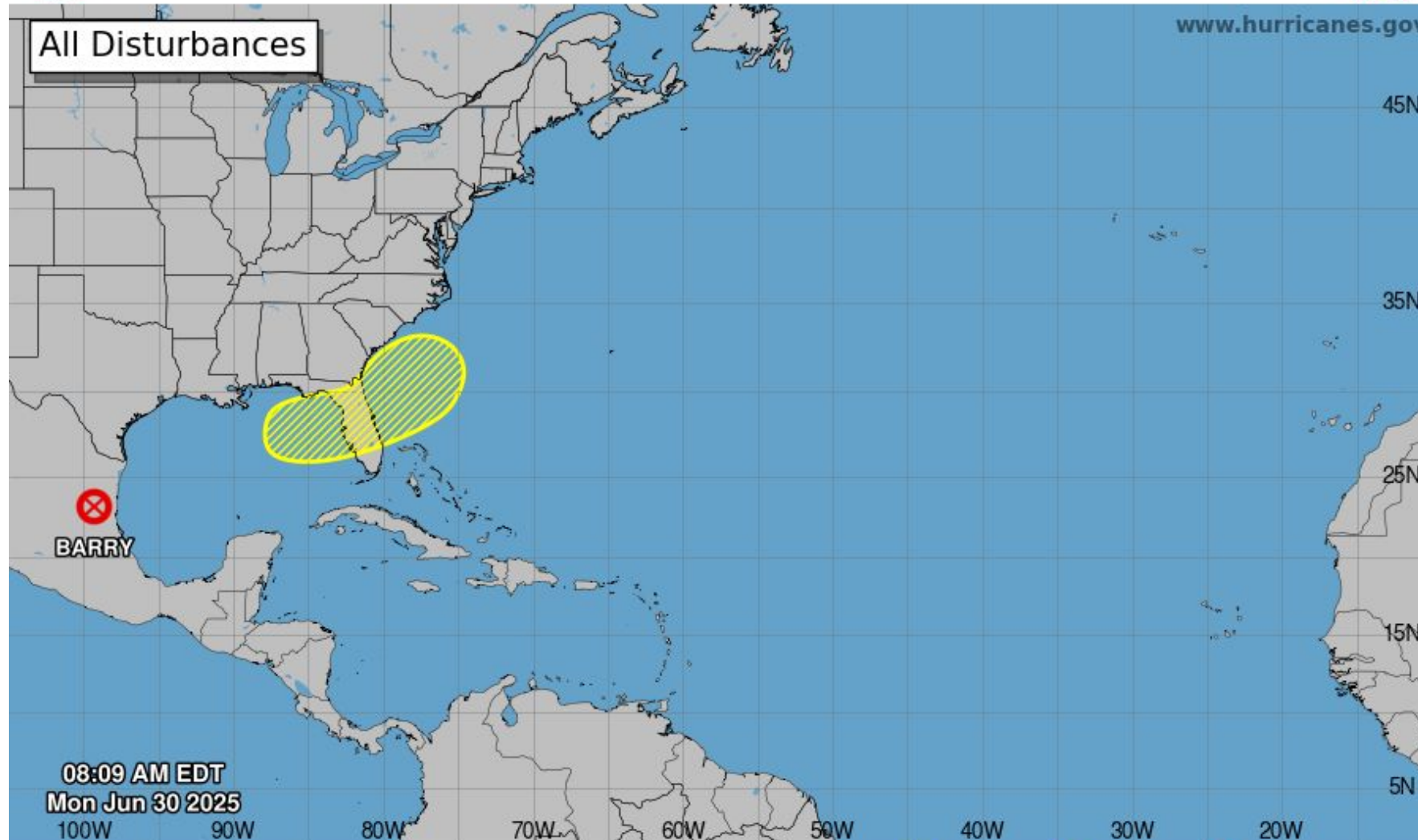
7 Day Outlook - Atlantic

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Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

National Hurricane Center Miami, Florida



Current Disturbances and Seven-Day Cyclone Formation Chance: < 40% 40-60% > 60%
Tropical or Sub-Tropical Cyclone: Depression Storm Hurricane
 Post-Tropical Cyclone or Remnants

A frontal boundary is expected to stall and weaken off the southeast U.S. coast late this week. An area of low pressure could develop from the weakening front by the weekend off the southeast U.S., over Florida, or over the eastern Gulf. Some gradual tropical or subtropical development could occur thereafter as the low moves little.



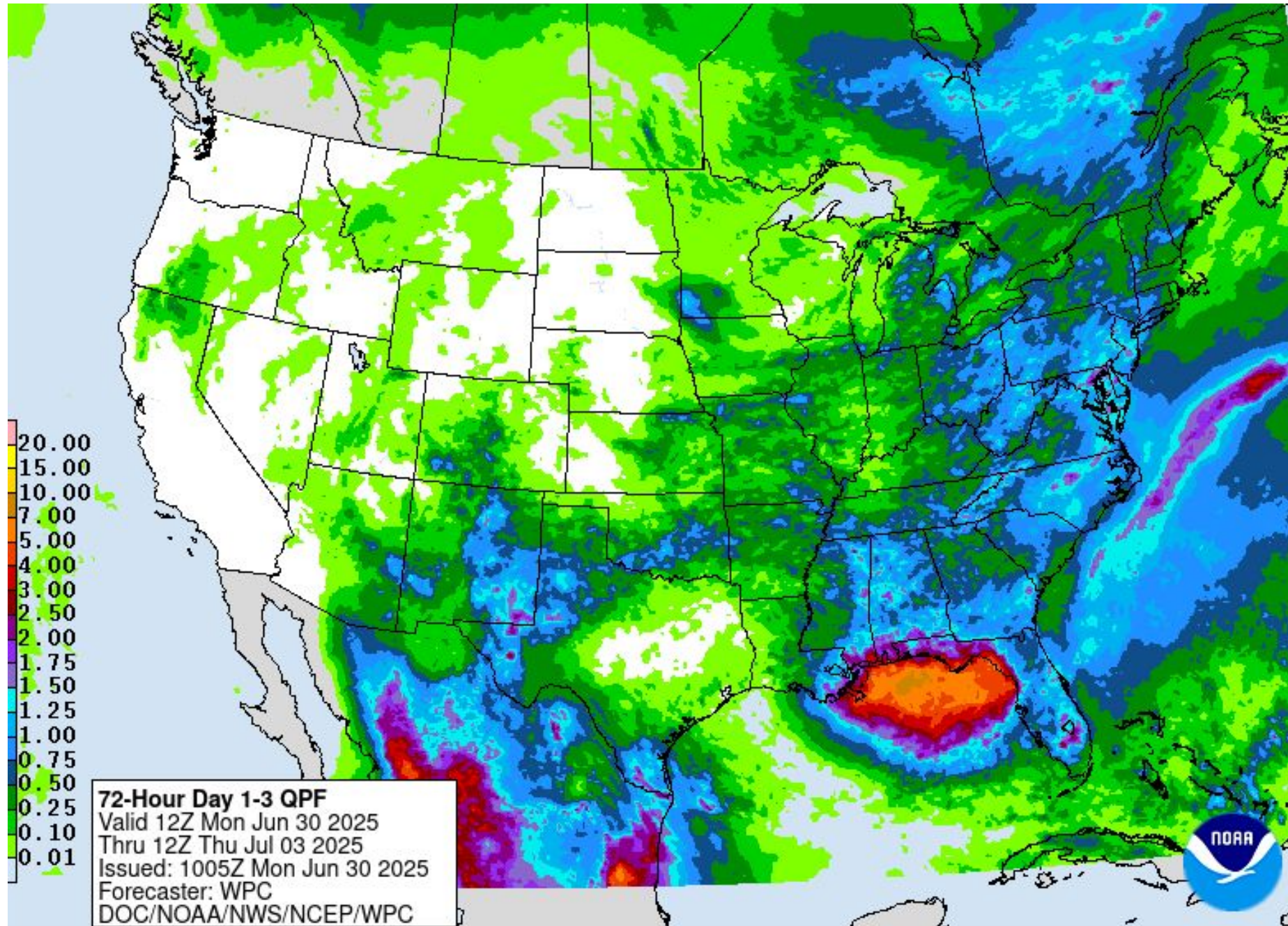
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Precipitation Accum - Next 3 Days

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Pockets of heavy rainfall in storms may lead to localized flash flooding. Widespread flooding is unlikely over the next 3 days.





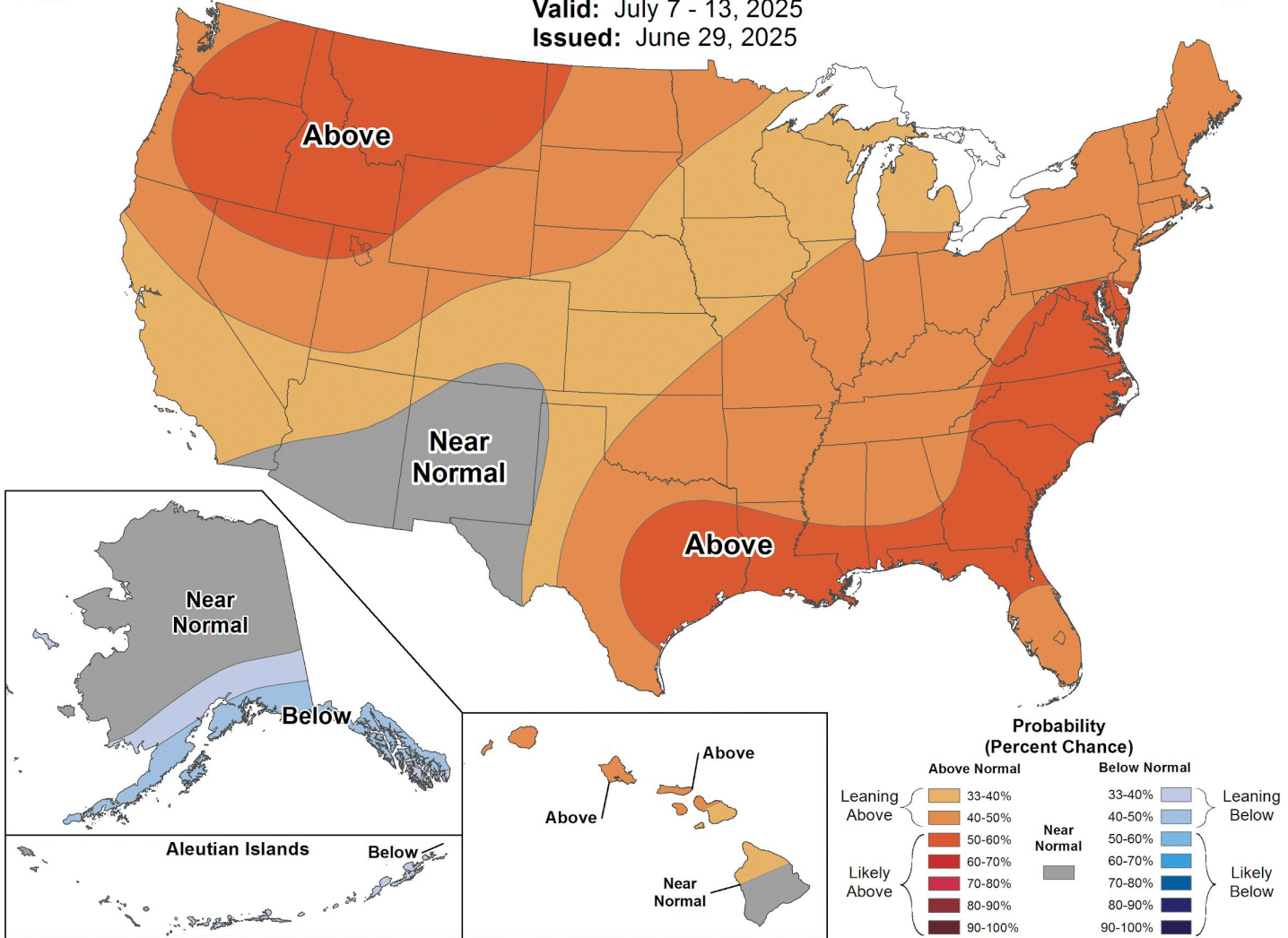
8-14 Day Outlook

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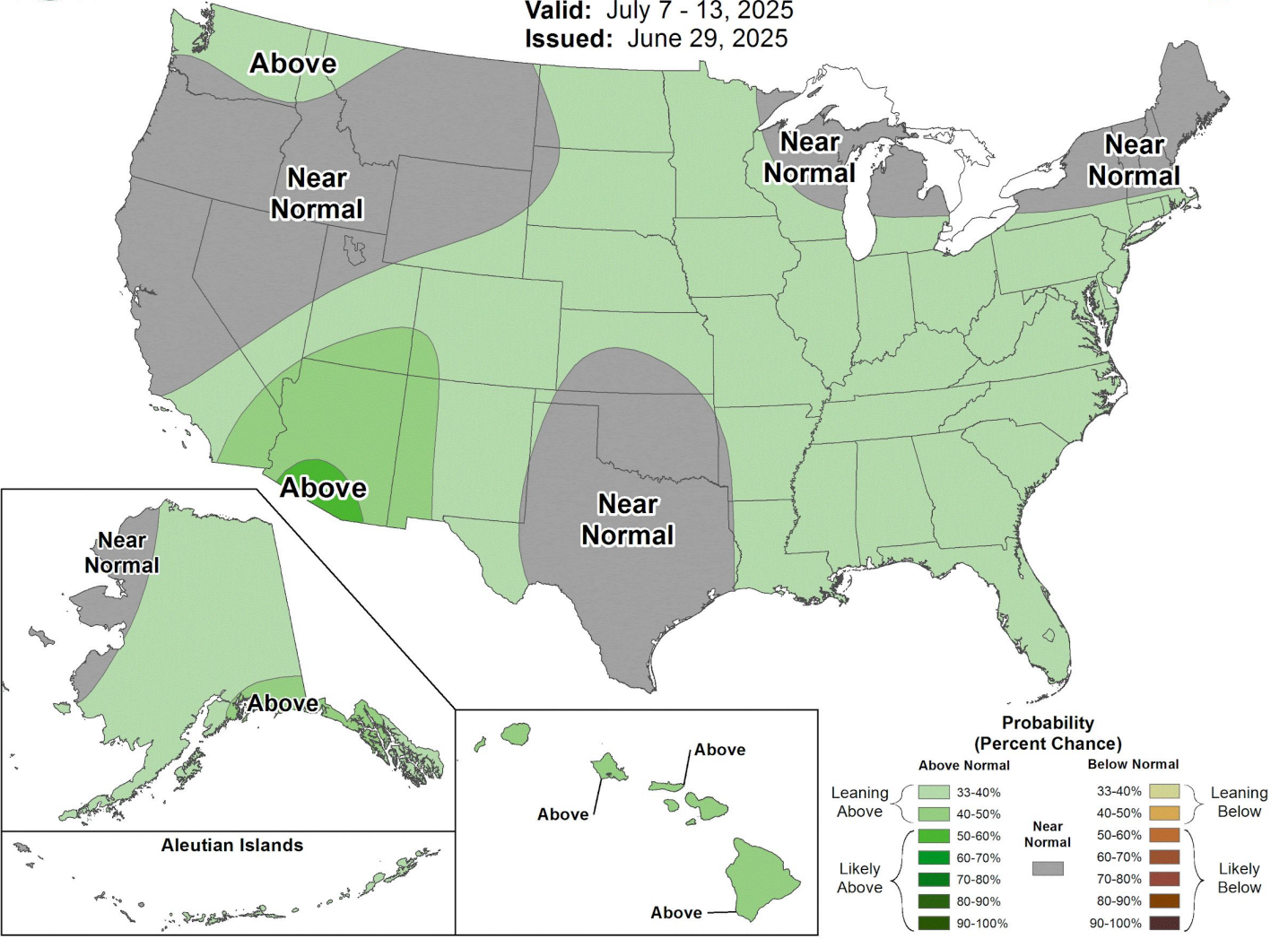
8-14 Day Temperature Outlook
