D. INLAND FLOODING...

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TWO TO 8 INCHES OF RAIN FELL ACROSS SOUTHEAST SOUTH CAROLINA AND SOUTHEAST GEORGIA AS HERMINE MOVED THROUGH THE AREA. THE HIGHEST RAIN AMOUNTS FELL WELL INLAND FROM THE COAST. NO SIGNIFICANT FLOODING WAS OBSERVED. A DAILY RAINFALL RECORD OF 2.32 INCHES WAS SET AT THE CHARLESTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FOR SEPT 2.

THE TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN AT 512 AM AND MOVED NORTHWARD THROUGH THE RESIDENTIAL AREA KNOWN AS THE LANDINGS. NUMEROUS HOMES WERE DAMAGED AND HUNDREDS OF LARGE PINE AND OAK TREES WERE EITHER SNAPPED OR UPROOTED. THE TORNADO WAS DETERMINED TO BE AN EF1 ON THE EF-SCALE WITH ESTIMATED MAXIMUM WINDS OF 105-110 MPH. THE TORNADO PATH LENGTH WAS ESTIMATED TO BE 1.67 MILES WITH A MAXIMUM PATH WIDTH OF 350 YARDS.

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THE TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN AT 350 AM JUST NORTH OF BLACKBEARD CREEK. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THE TORNADO SNAPPED OR UPROOTED A FEW THOUSAND TREES IN THE AREA AND ALSO CAUSED MINOR DAMAGE TO A FEW STRUCTURES. THE TORNADO WAS DETERMINED TO BE AN EF1 ON THE EF-SCALE WITH ESTIMATED MAXIMUM WINDS OF 105-110 MPH. THE TORNADO PATH LENGTH WAS ESTIMATED TO BE 4.83 MILES WITH A MAXIMUM PATH WIDTH OF 650 YARDS.

CLOSE TO 7000 PEOPLE WERE WITHOUT POWER DURING THE HEIGHT OF THE STORM. AT ONE POINT DURING THE STORM...ALL ENTRANCES TO SUMMERVILLE MEDICAL CENTER WERE CLOSED DUE TO A LIQUID OXYGEN LEAK THAT WAS CAUSED BY A TREE THAT FELL ON THE EXTERNAL TANK.

A DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WORKER WAS INJURED DURING THE STORM WHEN A TREE FEEL ON THE CAR HE WAS DRIVING WHILE ATTEMPTING TO CLEAR ANOTHER TREE THAT HAD FALLEN ACROSS THE ROAD.
