

## April 3, 2017, Severe Weather Event


A warm front lifted north over the area early in the day, establishing a warm sector and increasing instability over much of the Southeast United States, well ahead of a cold front approaching from the west. Aloft, a longwave mid/upper level trough of low pressure over the Central United States became negatively tilted while tracking east. As this occurred, an embedded 500 shortwave rounded the southern periphery of the longwave trough, shifting over the Southeast Monday afternoon. The combination of instability advecting north into the area, strong tropospheric winds and shear and forcing for ascent produced by the approaching 500 mb shortwave and entrance region of an upper level jet helped produce an environment capable of damaging straight-line winds, large hail and isolated tornadoes. Indeed, organized severe thunderstorms crossed the region Monday afternoon into early Monday evening, producing numerous reports of severe weather and an EF-0 tornado in Hampton County SC.






Monday morning 850 mb observations and analysis depicting deep low pressure pulling moisture into the Southeast.




Monday morning 500 mb observations and analysis depicting the deep upper trough advancing into the lower Mississippi River Valley and strengthening winds over the Southeast U.S.







Tornado and Severe Thunderstorm Watches issued April 3.






Experimental GOES-16 infrared and visible satellite imagery taken about 4 pm EDT.






Radar base reflectivity depicting thunderstorms spreading into western counties of the forecast area around 3 pm and advancing well into the forecast area around 5 pm EDT.




Radar base reflectivity imagery depicting thunderstorms along the coast and over adjacent Atlantic waters about 630 pm EDT.

...Summary...

The National Weather Service in Charleston SC has confirmed a weak, brief tornado occurred just east of Gifford in Hampton County South Carolina on 04/03/2017. A National Weather Service storm survey team found that the tornado touched down about 2.7 miles east of Gifford, SC, then traveled approximately one third

of a mile east-northeast before lifting near Thomas Hamilton Road.

The damage was limited to uprooting of small soft and hardwood trees. More widespread tree damage was just south of the tornado, associated with straight-line winds.
