*** 1 INJ *** HIGH WINDS AT THE CHARLESTON MARINA LAST NIGHT SUNK A 40 FOOT BOAT AND CAUSED MINOR TO MODERATE DAMAGED TO 20 TO 30 BOATS. ONE PERSON HAD A HAND CUT OFF TRYING TO TYE A BOAT TO THE DOCK. WITNESSES ESTIMATE THAT 70 KT WINDS OCCURRED CAUSING 4 TO 5 FT WAVES ON THE ASHLEY RIVER. DAMAGE WAS ESTIMATED TO OCCUR BETWEEN 11 PM AND 1 AM.
