...HIGH WIND WARNING IN EFFECT UNTIL 10 AM EST THIS MORNING...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN CHARLESTON HAS ISSUED A HIGH WIND WARNING...WHICH IS IN EFFECT UNTIL 10 AM EST THIS MORNING. THE WIND ADVISORY IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

WEST WINDS OF 35 MPH WITH OCCASIONAL GUSTS TO 50 MPH WILL CONTINUE ACROSS THE COASTAL AREAS OF SOUTHERN SOUTH CAROLINA AND SOUTHEAST GEORGIA THROUGH MID MORNING. MANY REPORTS OF TREES AND POWER LINES BEING BLOWN DOWN HAVE BEEN REPORTED TO THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE OVERNIGHT...AND THE RISK FOR ADDITIONAL DAMAGE WILL CONTINUE THROUGH 10 AM. WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO DIMINISH LATER THIS MORNING. WINDS COULD BE LOCALLY HIGHER NEAR LAKE MOULTRIE... PARTICULARLY ALONG THE EASTERN SHORE.

MOTORISTS...ESPECIALLY THOSE DRIVING HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES... ARE REMAIN ALERT FOR STRONG WINDS THROUGH MID MORNING TUESDAY. WINDS WILL BE PARTICULARLY HIGH ON ELEVATED BRIDGES SUCH AS THE ARTHUR RAVENEL BRIDGE AND THE TALMADGE MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

A WIND ADVISORY REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 10 AM EST THIS MORNING.

WEST WINDS OF 20 TO 30 WILL CONTINUE ACROSS INTERIOR PORTIONS OF SOUTHERN SOUTH CAROLINA AND SOUTHEAST GEORGIA THIS MORNING AS A STRONG UPPER LEVEL STORM SYSTEM CROSSES THE REGION. WIND GUSTS TO 40 TO 45 MPH ARE ALSO POSSIBLE. WINDS OF THIS MAGNITUDE CAN EASILY BREAK LARGE LIMBS OR BLOW LOOSE OUTSIDE OBJECTS AROUND.

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
