Subject:     Radar dome maintenance to the KCLX radar  
              ...updated to reflect new maintenance dates

The Weather Surveillance Radar-1988 Doppler (WSR-88D) located in Grays, SC, will undergo maintenance to the radar dome. Work on the dome is expected to take about 3-4 days and is scheduled to occur from March 16, 2026 to March 19 2026. During this period, radar data will not be available from the KCLX radar.

Users of KCLX radar data are urged to use adjacent WSR-88D sites which also cover much of Southeast South Carolina, Southeast Georgia and the adjacent coastal waters. These include:

KCAE - Columbia, SC  
KLTX - Wilmington, NC  
KJAX - Jacksonville, FL  
KVAX - Moody AFB, GA  
KJGX - Robbins AFB, GA
