Subject: New Forecast Service for the Edisto River below
 Canadys, SC (CERS1)

Effective June 17, 2026, the National Weather Service will officially begin forecast and warning services for the Edisto River below Canadys, SC (CERS1). Forecasts of river stage height will be issued by the Southeast River Forecast Center (SERFC) on a daily basis. River Flood Warnings (FLW) will be issued by NWS Charleston, SC on an as needed basis when the river is forecast to rise above Minor flood stage. The following flood impact categories have been determined for the site:

Action Stage:	17.5 feet
Flood Stage:	18.5 feet
Moderate flood stage:	20.0 feet
Major flood stage:	22.0 feet
