- A Winter Weather Advisory has been issued for southern Erie County, PA until 8 PM tonight.
- New snowfall amounts of 3 to 5 inches of snow expected in the higher elevations of southern Erie County, PA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ The Winter Weather Advisory is valid until 8 PM tonight.▪ The best window for the most intense snowfall rates will be from 8 AM to 2 PM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ New snowfall amounts of 3 to 5 inches of snow expected in the higher elevations of southern Erie County, PA.▪ Snowfall rates could be briefly intense around 1 inch/hour this morning.▪ Roads may become snow covered and slippery.▪ Winds will gust as high as 30 mph out of the northwest.
