Matt Grantham - Meteorologist narration "I'm a spotter and I see a downburst just west of town. Looks like very strong winds and large hail."

John Metz - Warning Coordination Meteorologist, interview at Texas A&M Corpus Christi Campus "Outdoor events are common across the nation. Sometimes these events are interrupted by the weather, placing hundreds if not thousands of people's lives in jeopardy. Knowing what to do, when hazardous weather approaches, could mean the difference between life and death."

John Metz interview outside "Fact is, there is no safe place outdoors

when a thunderstorm is nearby. The vast majority of storm victims were going to a safe place but waited too long before seeking safe shelter. "
