# NWS State College Application Process

Prospective students should:

- Fill out the Student Volunteer Application
  - Link to Google Form on <https://weather.gov/CTP/StudentVolunteers>
- Please upload materials below via the Google Form
  - resume,
  - college transcript, and
  - cover letter describing motivation and interests
- Well-qualified applicants will be interviewed before selection
- We generally limit selections to 1 to 3 students per academic semester
- Penn State students may enroll for up to 3 credits of independent study (talk to your advisor). This normally requires a paper and/or presentation to be completed at the end of the study period. Note: PSU requires at least 135 hours of work (8+ hrs/week) to qualify for a 3-credits for your work. Other universities may have similar programs.
