PTWC TSUNAMI MESSAGES FOR LANTEX MARCH 26, 2014 GULF OF MEXICO SCENARIO

For the LANTEX March 26, 2014 Gulf of Mexico Scenario, in support of CARIBE EWS, the PTWC will issue both a Dummy Message and simulated tsunami alert messages. While the Dummy Message will be transmitted over the standard broadcast channels of the PTWC (Table 1), in order to receive the simulated alert messages (Table 2), the interested party must have registered and requested these products.  EARTHQUAKE.

A TSUNAMI THREAT EXISTS FOR COASTAL AREAS OF MEXICO AND CUBA
 BORDERING OR ADJACENT TO THE GULF OF MEXICO.

WHEN NO MAJOR WAVES HAVE OCCURRED FOR AT LEAST TWO HOURS AFTER
