In effect through 10 AM this morning

Key Points...

- Mixed precipitation expected this morning. Total snow accumulations up to two inches across the Tri-Cities and Thumb and up to a tenth of an inch of ice accumulations.
- ✓ Winds will be gusting to 35 mph after sunrise.
- ✔ Plan on slippery road conditions, especially on elevated surfaces. The hazardous conditions will impact the Wednesday morning commute.
- ✓ Any snow and ice accumulations will rapidly melt-off during the afternoon and early evening hours, prior to the afternoon and evening thunderstorm activity.


Travel Impacts

Plan ahead! Check the forecast and give yourself extra time to get to your destination.








A quick quarter-inch of snow, up to an inch and a half, will be possible in a 3 hour window before the transition to freezing rain and eventually all rain

- → A glaze or up to a tenth of ice accumulation possible in the morning.






Interior Thumb Region



ICE & SNOW, TAKE IT SLOW
