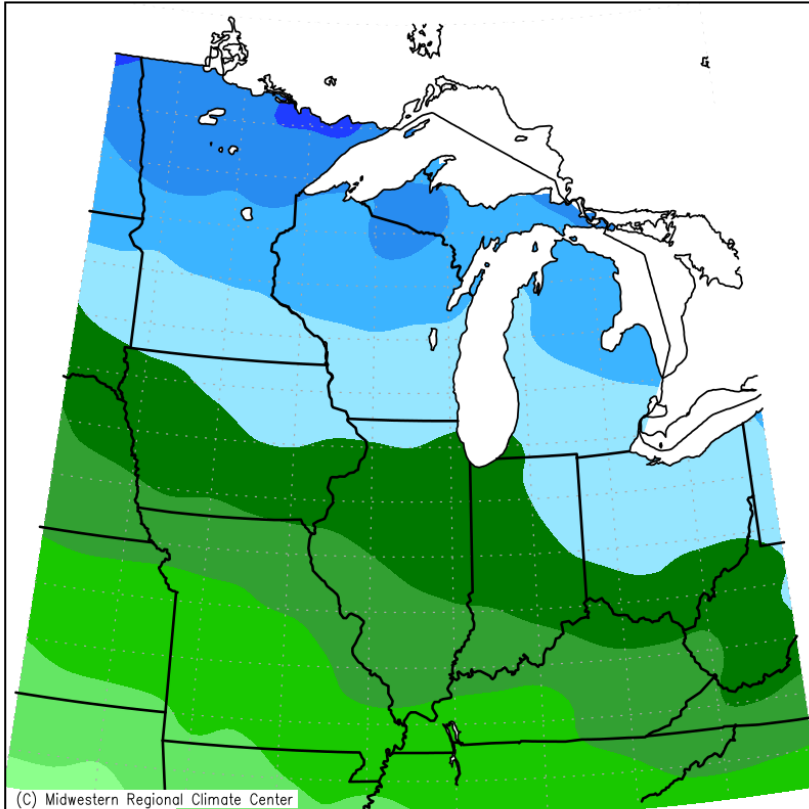

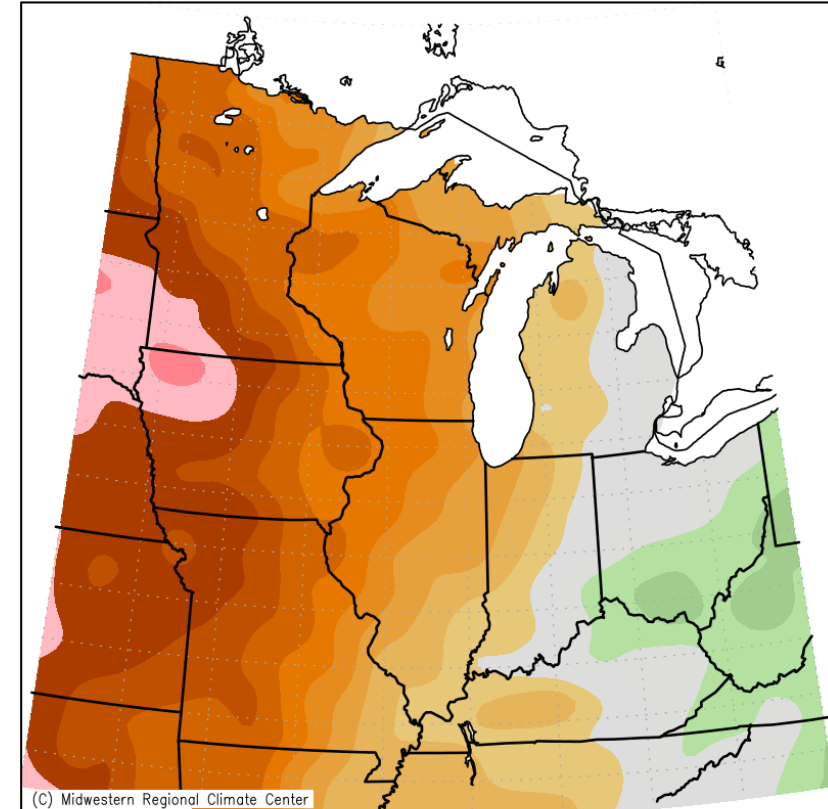
Average Temperature (left) & Departure from Average (right)

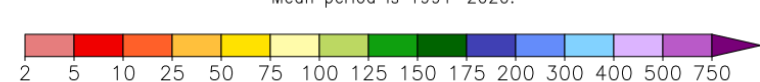
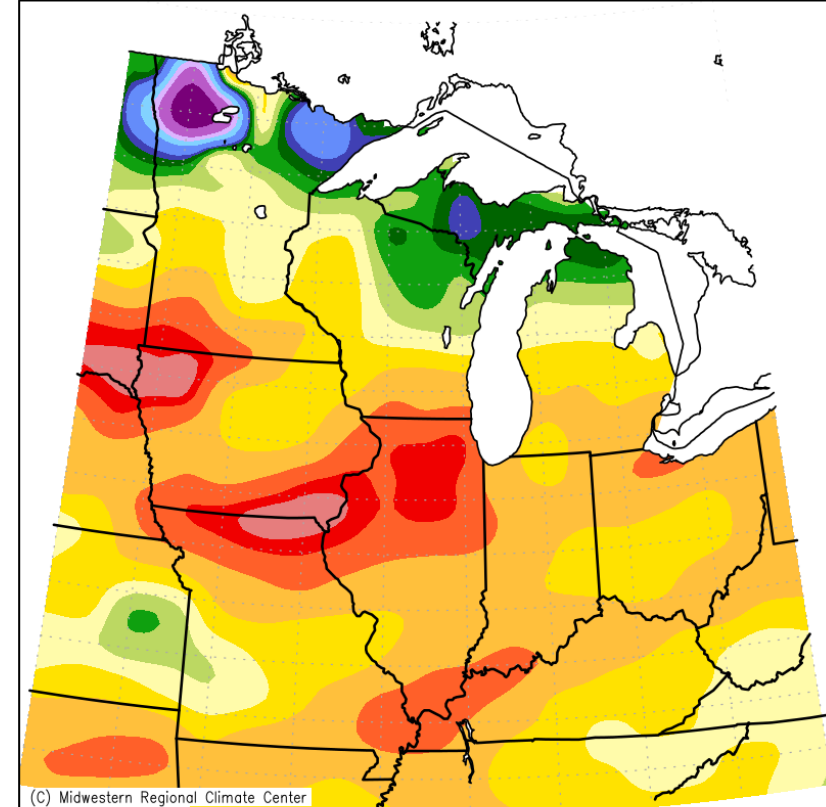
Total Monthly Precipitation (left) & Percent of Mean (right)

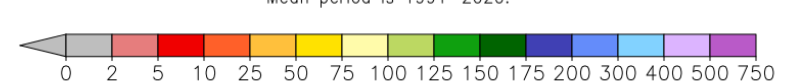
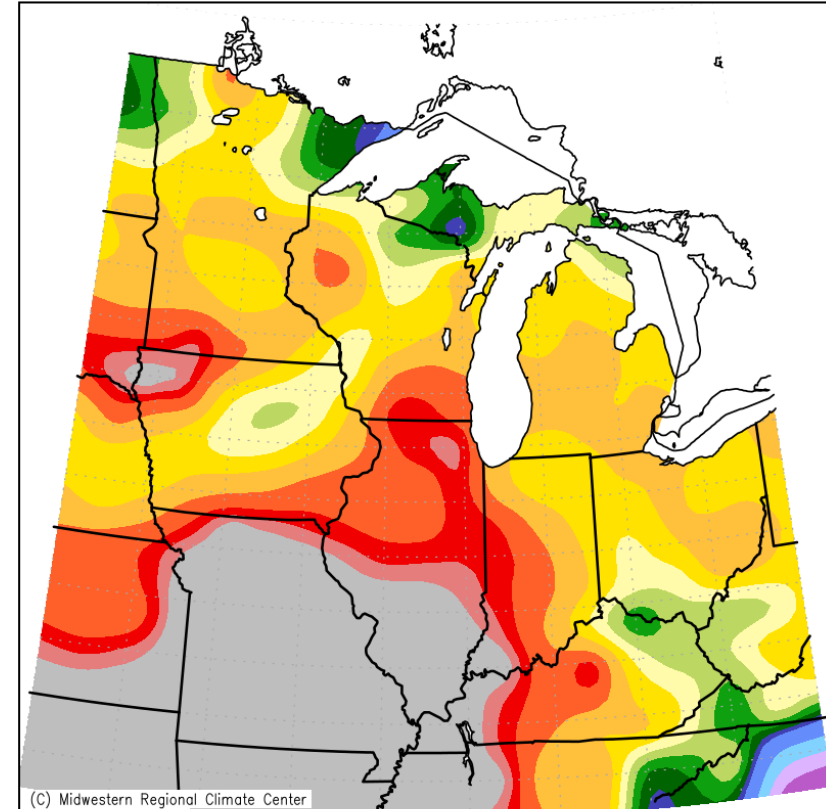
Total Monthly Snowfall (*left*) & Departure from Normal (*right*)

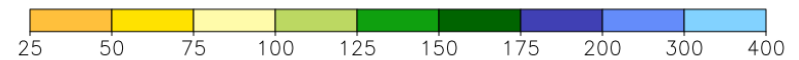
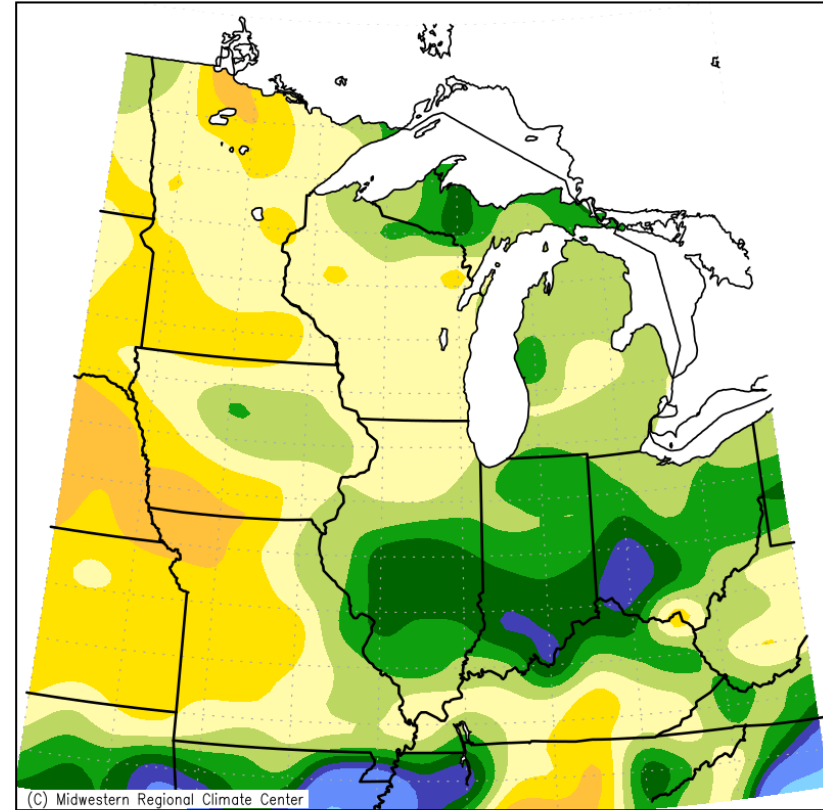
Total Snowfall (left) & Departure from Normal (right)

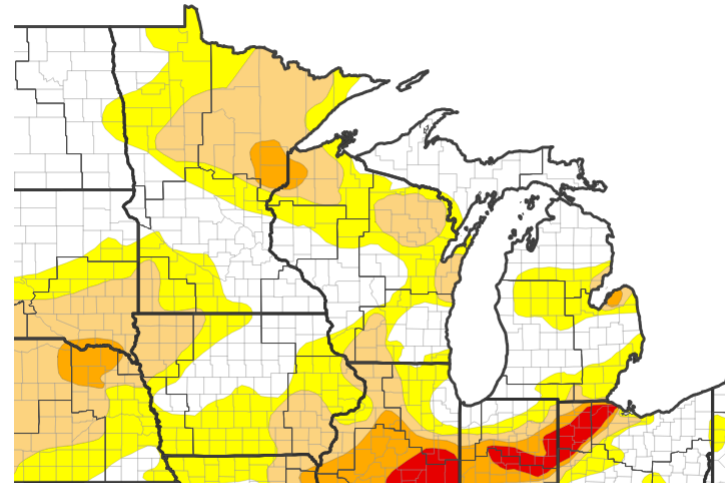

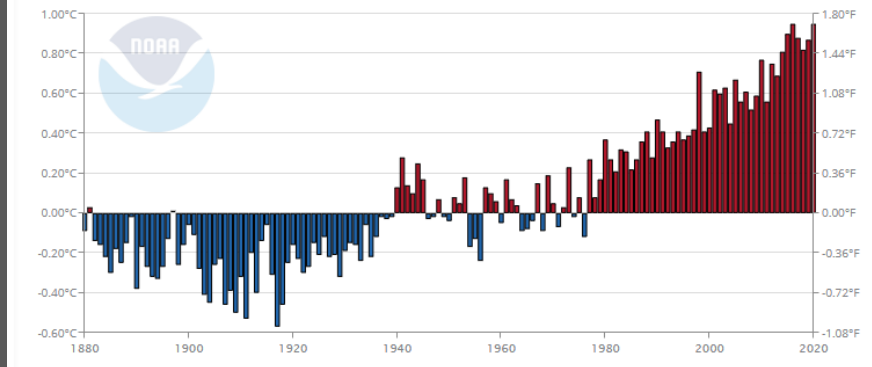
