




Hurricane Odile was a tropical cyclone that affected Mexico during the 2014 Eastern Pacific Hurricane season. It made landfall over the state of Baja California Sur, Mexico on September 15, 2014 as a Category 3 hurricane. The hurricane weakened as it traveled up the Baja California Peninsula and the southern Arizona region. The remnants of this hurricane eventually passed through the El Paso and southern New Mexico region from September 16-19.

Odile at Landfall Sep 14




Odile Remnants over El Paso Region Sep 18
