

# July 2020 Climate Summary



The month of July saw warmer than average temperatures due to the lack of monsoonal moisture as well as a persistent and strong area of high pressure over the region. July saw minimal amounts of rainfall and was overall well below monthly averages across the state. Eastern portions of the state near the White Mountains saw more precipitation but still ranked below average.
