

July 2021 Climate Summary



Monsoon season arrived in a major way across northern Arizona in July. Rainfall totals were in the 150-300% of normal range. Many areas experienced flash flooding by the second half of the month, resulting in property damage and loss of life. A brief heat wave from the 7th-12th brought near all-time records for a few locations, including Winslow at 110°F.
