

MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR NOVEMBER 2019

... NOVEMBER TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

A series of storm systems during the second half of the month brought heavy rain and snow to northern Arizona. As a result, monthly precipitation was much above normal, with several locations in the top 5 all-time wettest Novembers. This was an abrupt end to an extended period of much below normal precipitation that lasted from June through October.

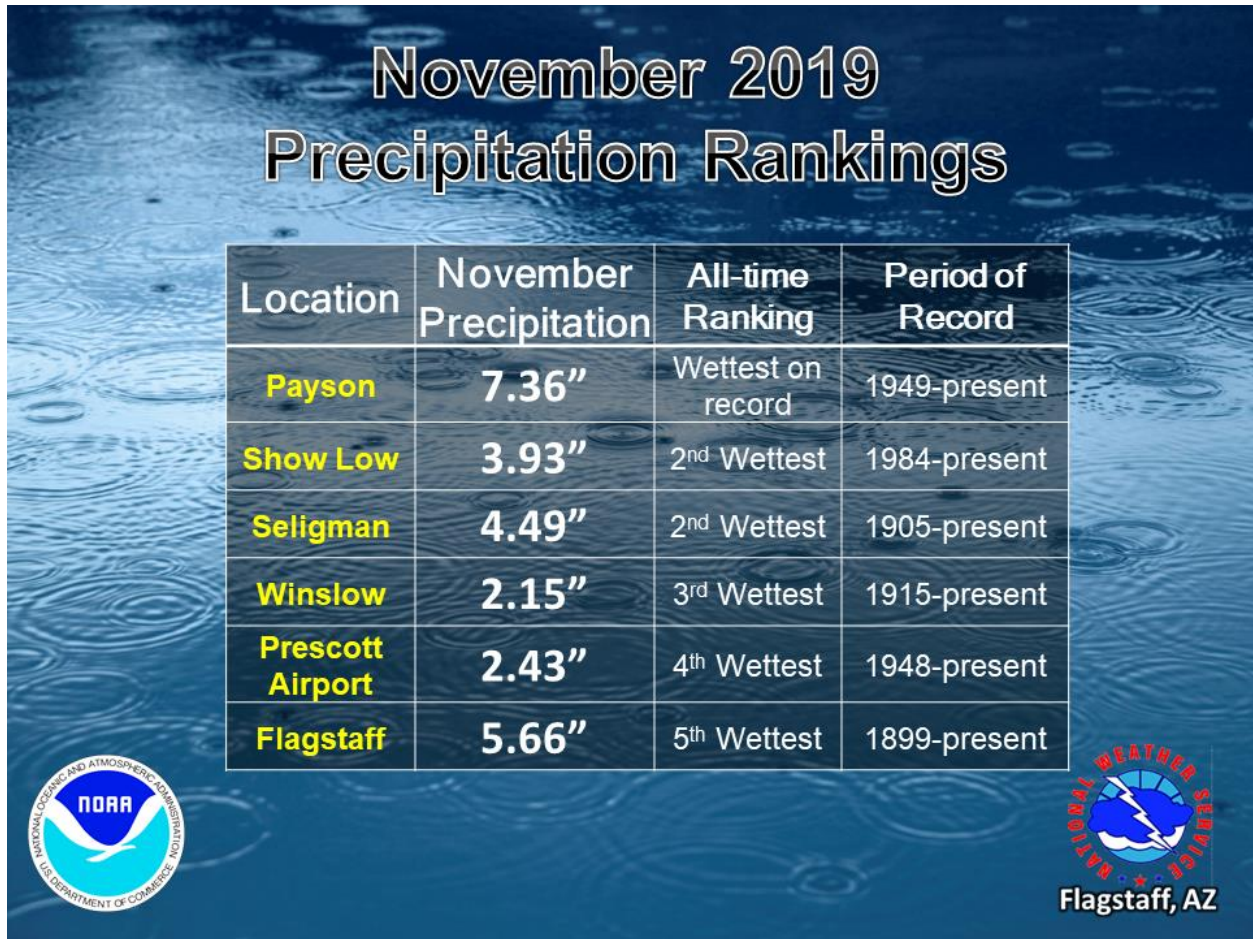

...Winter Storm Nov 28-29...

A large winter storm brought moderate to heavy rain to the region on Thanksgiving (Nov 28). Snow levels fell rapidly during the early morning hours Nov 29th as a powerful cold front moved through. Heavy snow accumulations occurred down to around 4500 feet elevation, resulting in numerous road closures, power outages, and stranding people in their homes in some rural areas.
