October 2022 Climate Summary



October was much wetter than normal across most of northern and central Arizona with the exception of northwest Coconino County. Much of this precipitation fell due to a storm system on October 15-16. Temperatures were near to below normal.

EF-1 tornado 7 miles north of Williams with estimated peak wind gust of 95 mph. Caused damage to trees, vehicles, and buildings but no injuries.

High winds ahead of a late night cold frontal passage. Flagstaff hit 61 mph, Heber 60 mph, Williams 58 mph.
