04:05 <nws-dennis.cavanaugh> Nestor, from what I can see from the 00z nam and gfs, yes, expect accumulating snow to remain west or northwest of the metroplex

04:07 <nws-dennis.cavanaugh> The 00z GFS and the 12z ECMWF both show that the system has the potential to strengthen quite a bit Sunday night into Monday morning though. There is likely to be an incredible gradient between high impact winter weather and virtually nothing somewhere just west of the DFW area. Of course if the NAM is right, this intensification will not occur, keeping the wintry impacts well off to the northwest.

04:09 <nws-dennis.cavanaugh> The storm system looks very strong though, so dynamically, the GFS and ECMWF are likely on the right track that the storm system will intensify Sunday evening through Monday morning. Where that fine line winds up is hard to say, but almost all guidance I've seen keeps snow along and northwest of a Bridgeport to Stephenville line... if north farther northwest.

04:10 <media-nestor.s.flecha> How confident are you with the storm trajectory? At the end of the day, that will be the key factor for us to draw the impact line..

04:14 <nws-dennis.cavanaugh> Yes, I agree that the track of the upper level storm system will play a big role in how far southeast snow makes it. The 12Z ECMWF had the track right on top of the metroplex. This is in between the NAM (farther northwest) and the GFS. This likely represents the best track for now. We'll see how the 00Z ECMWF comes in of course. The dry slot is likely to be right in the middle of the storm track, so the wintry precip should remain at least 30-40 miles west/northwest of the center of the upper low.

- 15:01 <nws-dennis.cavanaugh> The risk of severe weather today is pretty much active/possible all day. Our 12Z sounding did have a cap in place... but it's weak. The environment is supportive of supercells capable of producing tornadoes. The main missing ingredient is lift/a focusing mechanism for convection. IF any storms develop in the warm sector, they will likely become severe quickly and pose a tornado threat. The challenge will be getting storms to develop in the warm sector. We'll be watching closely. If storms start to develop, expect a red box fairly quickly from us/SPC. Clouds will inhibit warming today... but not prevent it. As a result, severe storms are a bit more likely this afternoon.

The "parameter space" for our sounding rates on the significant tornado scale for all relevant indices based on SPC severe weather environment climatology. What we're "missing" is strong lift. At this point, any storm that gets going will have the potential to become organized quickly and may pose a significant tornado threat. We (us and SPC) will be watching for any signs of enhanced lift. Any sign of lift will likely prompt a quick tornado watch.
