Crops continue to suffer or are not being planted and stock tanks are drying up due to the lack of rain. Farmers and ranchers are having to buy feed stock for cattle due to the lack of grazing areas. The fire danger continued to rise during the month with 42 of 46 counties having Burn Bans.

A NWS survey confirmed straight line winds up to 80 MPH caused significant damage in Laguna Park. Evidence of wind damage began west of town and continued to east of the airstrip. At the beginning of the damage track, an inside wall was knocked down in a business and metal roof paneling was torn off the structure. In town, numerous homes sustained minor damage, numerous trees were uprooted or snapped, and an airplane hanger was flattened. Storm spotters in Laguna Park reported that their truck was lifted several feet off the ground by the high winds.
