A complex of thunderstorms rolled across the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex early morning on Wednesday September 9th. Lightning from one storm struck an apartment complex, setting fire to it and damaging 16 units. No injuries were reported, but 27 people were displaced.

A weak cold front pushed south across the Red River Tuesday Night and was accompanied by a broken line of showers and storms as it encroached on the Interstate 20 corridor early Wednesday morning. As a cluster of storms moved across the Dallas-Fort Worth area, lightning struck and set fire to an apartment complex in Irving, damaging 16 units.
