


# Snow Forecast Reduced, Strong Winds Still Expected

## Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast

Valid: 01/11/2020 12:00 PM - 01/12/2020 06:00 AM CST



### Message of the Day:

✓ The snow expected Saturday evening through Saturday night continues to shift east, reducing the snowfall forecast significantly. The highest amounts are still expected along the lake shore south of Kewaunee. Strong winds will create blowing and drifting snow, which may be more impactful than the snow itself in some places.

### Important Forecast Changes

**NEW** Once again, forecast snowfall amounts have dropped significantly. Winter Weather Headlines have been adjusted to represent the new forecast (see page 3). It's possible these snow amounts are still too high.



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### Key Points



**Hazards:** Moderate snow, blowing and drifting snow, high winds, bay shore and lake shore flooding, and ice shoves.



**Areas Impacted:** Worst conditions over east- central Wisconsin. Snow, along with blowing and drifting snow, will also impact parts of the Fox Valley and northeast Wisconsin. Winds and flooding potential are greatest along the bay and lake shore.



#### Timing & Duration:

Wintry weather: 3:00 pm Saturday – 6:00 am Sunday

Lakeshore flooding: Now – 3:00 am Sunday




#### Impacts:

- Snow will create snowy and slippery roads.
- High winds will create blowing and drifting snow (especially for counties in the Winter Storm Warning), low visibilities, and possibly a few power outages across east- central Wisconsin.
- Roads, parking lots, and buildings along the immediate shoreline of Green Bay from Marinette into the city of Green Bay, and along the Lake Michigan shoreline may become flooded.




**Certainty & Considerations:** Confidence is medium-low for snowfall amounts. Would not be surprised if these amounts need to be reduced even further. Confidence is medium-high on strong winds, and medium for lake/bay shore flooding.





## Snow Forecast Reduced, Strong Winds Still Expected



**High Winds:** Highest wind gusts are a little lower than the previous forecast, but are still expected to create blowing/drifting snow Saturday afternoon into early Sunday. Winds may also lead to flooding along the lake and bay shore.

## Winter Weather Preparedness Info



- A **Winter Weather Advisory** is issued when conditions may produce some travel inconveniences.
- A **Winter Storm Watch** is issued when conditions are favorable for significant winter weather and/or blizzard conditions. *Time to prepare!*
- A **Winter Storm Warning** is issued when a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and possibly ice mixed with snow is expected to impact the area. *Time to act!*
- A **Blizzard Warning** is issued when the combination of strong wind, low visibility, and heavy snow will significantly impact daily life.

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
