The warm weather of the past 2 weeks is about to end!

The November temperature departure from normal through the 15th :


Grand Rapids +6.4 °

Lansing +6.4 °


Muskegon +5.9 °

For November's that have averaged more than 5° above normal through the 15th (2008, 2005, 1977, 1975, 1964), the last week averaged 5° below normal

Average Temperature (°F): Departure from Mean November 1, 2015 to November 14, 2015



Mean period is 1981–2010.
