Event Summary

Tropical Storm Higos (08W) started as Invest 94W, east of the Marianas near 13.0N 152.2E at 6 UTC, June 21 (4PM ChST, June 21). It slowly moved west-northwest toward the Marianas, organizing and became was the subject of a Tropical Cyclone Formation Alert (TCFA), issued by the Joint Typhoon Warning Center (JTWC) at 11 UTC, June 22 (9 PM ChST, June 22) when it was about 216 miles east-northeast of Guam near 14.5N 147.7E. Invest 94W would become Tropical Depression 08W 185 miles east-northeast of Guam and 125 miles east-southeast of Saipan 15 UTC June 22 (1AM ChST, June 23). As 08W would be upgraded to Tropical Storm Higos at 3 UTC, June 23 (1PM ChST, June 23) as it moved through the Marianas, 25 miles south of Tinian or 35 miles south-southwest of Saipan near 14.6N 145.6E. The convection and wind field of of TS Higos was asymmetric, located west-northwest of the center, with max sustained winds of 40 mph. As Higos slowly moved away from the Marianas, rainfall and winds slowly decreased across Tinian and Saipan through the evening and early overnight hours, allowing the Tropical Storm Warning for Tinian and Saipan to be canceled at 16 UTC, June 23 (2AM ChST, June 24).

NOTE: It is unlikely that the point-based observations provided in this report sampled the peak values for the event.
