ASCAT-B on the morning of the 22nd of August shows winds of 70 to 80 knots. Updates will be made available if or when we can hear from the inhabitants.

ASCAT-B on the morning of the 22nd of August shows winds of 40 to 50 knots. Updates will be made available if or when we can hear from the inhabitants.

ASCAT-B on the morning of the 22nd of August shows winds of 65 to 75 knots. Updates will be made available if or when we can hear from the inhabitants.

On the afternoon of the 21st, Saipan airport had a sustained wind of 04018KT at 2:00 PM with a peak wind of 36027KT at 1:32 PM. AMME NPS had a gust to 25 KT in the morning and 0.71 inches of rain. Because the outer rainbands of Saudel only brushed the northeastern Saipan Waters, Saipan itself did not receive the damaging winds or heavy rain.

On the morning of the 21st, Tinian had a sustained wind of 15 knots with a gust to 20 knots. Saudel ended up passing well northeast of Tinian, so Tinian itself did not receive damaging winds or heavy rain.

Saudel moved away from Pakin as a Tropical Depression, before it intensified into a Tropical Storm. Therefore no significant effects were observed.

Saudel moved away from Sapwuafik as a Tropical Depression, before it intensified into a Tropical Storm. Therefore, no significant effects were observed.

On the 19th of August, at 0551Z, Chuuk had an estimated west-southwest wind of 15 gusting to 25 knots. 1.13 inches of rain, and a minimum sea level pressure of 1005.4 mb. This is because Saudel passed too far north of Chuuk for the strong winds or heavy rains to impact them.
