


Volunteers Needed to Measure Precipitation – Join CoCoRaHS!



Measuring precipitation is important for many reasons, ranging from long-term drought monitoring to determining an imminent flash flood threat. However, it can be highly variable in time and space and there can be large gaps in reliable observed precipitation data.

The good news is that you can help! CoCoRaHS is a network of volunteers who measure and report precipitation at their location on a regular basis. While there is an initial investment (purchasing and installing a rain gauge), from there, you simply record your precipitation and report it using your computer or smartphone.

There is no limit to the number of CoCoRaHS observers in a particular area; in fact, more is better! **We are looking for interested individuals especially within the shaded areas** to help us fill in the larger data gaps in our region, but all are welcome to join.
