
Volunteers Needed to Measure Precipitation – Join CoCoRaHS!



Measuring precipitation is important for many reasons ranging from drought monitoring to determining an imminent flash flood threat. However, it can be highly variable in time and space and there can be large gaps in precipitation data.

The good news is that you can help! The CoCoRaHS network consists of volunteers who measure and report precipitation at their location on a regular basis. While there is an initial investment (purchasing and installing a rain gauge), from there, you simply record and report your precipitation online.
